Dennis Springs—5'6" G Holland 22.2 ppg


Makes players around him better. Great range. Tough competitor—3.5 rpg.

Great hands. Passes well for a big man. Very solid on the offensive glass.

Tenacious competitor terrific rebounder. Creates match-up problems defends taller players well.

Athletic big man—great leaper. Soft touch around the rim

NBA prospect—led the league in scoring wire to wire. Has great footwork and shooting touch.

Great perimeter player-lights out shooter. Reliable defender

Talented scorer (35.3 ppg last year). Great shooting touch and range.



Rock Winston—6'7" F Tri-City 21.0 ppg

Very physical on the interior. Great footwork and soft hands.





Brad Lechtenberg—6'2" **Vancouver** 25.0 ppg

Best pure shooter in the minors. Lightning quick release.



Kevin Bloodsaw—6'5" F Vancouver 19.6 ppg

Dynamic player—scores from all over the court. Creative around the rim. Great finisher.
