VOLCANOES ADD RETURNING ALL-STAR TO 2006 ROSTER

Vancouver, WA--The Vancouver Volcanoes—a second year professional basketball team from the International Basketball League—signed their ninth player for the 2006 season—Power Forward Eric Dunn (6’ 9” University of Oregon).

Last year Eric Dunn played all 22 games for the Vancouver Volcanoes averaging 16.9 points per game. Eric Dunn will be playing alongside his former IBL All Star teammate Kevin ‘Pip’ Bloodsaw—who also re-signed with the Vancouver Volcanoes.

Two unique features distinguish the IBL from other professional basketball leagues:

- 1) **Extremely low travel costs.** The IBL promises a maximum of one trip requiring air travel; this means that IBL teams will ‘make it’ financially.
- 2) **An entertaining game.** By allowing only one timeout per quarter and reducing the time between plays with an immediate inbounds, IBL games were fast and entertaining. In 2005 the IBL team scoring average was 127 points per game (and this game occurred in 2 hours).
