I-5 Showdown Set For Friday In Eastmoreland

The red hot Portland Chinooks are entering the home stretch of the 2013 International Basketball League season with six games left in regular play. They'll take on I-5 rival Salem on Friday night at 7:00pm at Eastmoreland Courts, coming off one of their biggest wins of the season.
