Ashley, now in her third season as a Blazer dancer, credits the experience and opportunity the Volcanoes provided. "What helped me the most is the dance experience itself. We had multiple different choreographers on the Volcanoes come and teach our routines, and let me tell you they don't teach very slow. The dance experience made me a well rounded dancer that could pick up material quick, just what you need to be a Blazer Dancer," the Blazer Dancer shared.

Jenna Lea, a Volcanoes favorite, has been a Blazer Dancer since 2011, while Erika moved to the Rosebuds, Thunder dancers and now back to the Blazers, it is apparent the program Coach Desiree and Armani have put together moves talent. New members with the squad this season have made the Portland Winterhawk <u>Rosebuds</u> for the first time, Salam, Kasey, Brianna and Halee developed their skills, learned more about the pros with the support of their coaches and will become ice dancers this fall for the WHL team.

"I am extremely proud of my dancers that auditioned for Blazers this year," Vancouver Volcanoes Dancers Head Coach Desiree Goode shared, a former Blazer dancer herself. "The competition was fierce and there were a lot of talented and beautiful young ladies that auditioned. Overall I love being able to go and support all of our dancers. It is so much fun to watch and I enjoy being a part of the process. It is one of the highlights of my year to watch any and all of my dancers audition and make other teams. To see them grow as a dancer and as a women is a privilege."

Just up the I-5 north, the Seattle Seahawks are in full swing with two Volcanoes Dancer alumni Haley and Tamaria as <u>Sea</u> <u>Gals</u> ready to cheer them on to another championship this season.
